SUBJECT: KYTC Agreement for Citation Trail Phase 2 Project – Right Of Way Phase

**Request:** Council authorization to execute agreement with the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet to accept federal funds in the amount of \$25,120 for the right of way phase of the Citation Trail Phase 2, as funded under the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet Surface Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) for capital improvements projects. Required matching funds of \$6,280 are budgeted.

**Purpose of the Request:** The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet has approved for the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government to use federal funds from the TAP Program for the right of way phase of the Citation Trail Phase 2 Project.

The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet has offered the LFUCG funds for the right of way phase in the amount of \$25,120. Local match in the amount of \$6,280 is required for a total right of way phase cost of \$31,400.

The Citation Trail Phase 2 project will construct a 10' wide shared use path that completes a portion of the connection from Masterson Hills Park to the Town Branch Trail. The path is 1000 feet in length and connects the Great Acres Development and Masterson Station neighborhoods to Masterson Hills Park and the Town Branch Trail.

The cost in this budget year and future budget years: \$31,400 has been awarded for FY23 (\$25,120 federal funds and \$6,280 local match). Future years' funding is dependent upon availability.

Are the funds budgeted? Budget amendment is in process.
