**SUBJECT: KYTC Agreement for Armstrong Mill Drive Shared Use Path Project –  
Design Phase**

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**Request:** Council authorization to accept \$200,000 in federal funds and execute agreement for the design phase of the Armstrong Mill Shared Use Path Project as funded under the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSSA) for capital improvements projects. No matching funds required.

**Purpose of Request:** The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet has approved for the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government to use federal funds from the CRRSSA Program for the design of the Alumni Shared Use Path Project.

The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet has offered the LFUCG \$200,000 in funds for the design phase. A local match is not required for the project. This project has a total design phase cost of \$200,000.

The Armstrong Mill Shared Use Path project will make the shared use trail continuous along Armstrong Mill Rd. between Appian Way and Squires Hill Lane

**What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years?** The cost for Fiscal Year 2023 is \$200,000 and \$0 local match. Future years funding is dependent upon availability of grant funding.

**Are the funds budgeted?** Budget amendment is in process.
