Promulgation

The Lexington Fayette Emergency Operations Plan (EOP) dated February 2021 provides the framework in which responding departments and agencies, along with nongovernmental community partners, plan, coordinate, and perform their respective emergency functions during an emergency or disaster.

This plan supersedes all previous plans promulgated by Lexington Fayette and is officially adopted and approved by the Mayor and Urban County Council. This plan will be implemented whenever lifesaving and/or environmental or property protection services cannot by accomplished within the routine daily function of governmental departments or agencies within Lexington Fayette.

This plan is prepared in accordance with federal, state, and local statues. It will be exercised, revised, and updated as required.

KRS 39B.030 Paragraph (3) states: "The executive order shall be filed with the office of the clerk for the local jurisdiction and a copy placed in the local emergency operations plan."
