SUBJECT:

Create position - HANDS Nurse, Division of Family Services

Request:

The attached action is requesting authorization to create one (1) unclassified position of HANDS Nurse (Grade 514E) in the Division of Family Services, effective upon passage by Council.

Why are you requesting?

The Division is requesting this position to provide health education to the families enrolled in the HANDS (Health Access Nurturing Development Services) program will conduct the intake process with parents prenatally to promote positive pregnancy outcomes and positive family decision making. In addition, they will offer all families information and referrals to appropriate community resources.

Upon the request of the division, and in accordance with Section 22-2 (d) of the Code of Ordinances, the Division of Human Resources conducted a classification study on the requested position of HANDS Nurse within the Division of Family Services. The position was analyzed by staff using the whole job rank and factor comparison methods. As a result, a recommendation for their requested position is described in this action.

What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years?

To illustrate, this has a 12-month future impact of a cost of \$54,248.00.
