Request

The Division of Water Quality recommends the approval of a Clinical Education Agreement between the University of Kentucky and LFUCG for student interns to work and receive training at the Town Branch Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP) laboratory.

Why are you requesting?

This agreement between the University of Kentucky and LFUCG would provide student intern staff support to the Division of Water Quality treatment plant laboratory at no cost to LFUCG. In exchange, the laboratory staff would provide training and practical, hands-on educational experience for the students related to their field of study.

What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years?

There is no cost to LFUCG for the interns to work at the Division of Water Quality treatment plant laboratory—the University of Kentucky will pay the interns and cover insurance.
