

SUBJECT: Sole Source Purchase Request
Sanitary Sewer Monitoring and Alarm Equipment

Request

The Division of Water Quality (DWQ) requests a resolution authorizing a professional services contract with ADS Environmental Services (ADS), a sole source provider, for sewer overflow monitoring / reporting services related to the existing monitoring system located at 18 strategic locations within the service area.

Purpose of Request

In June 2014, ADS was awarded a unit price contract for Sewer Monitoring and Alarm Equipment (Resolution No. 275-2014). The current contract expires in June 2017. As part of the current contract, proprietary monitors and equipment were installed by ADS and became the property of LFUCG.

The continued flow monitor, operation / maintenance services, cell service, and web hosting components of the current contract are essential for the future use of the existing monitoring system. Therefore, DWQ recommends awarding ADS a Sole Source Provider contract for continuing the service established in 2014.

Project Cost in FY17 and in Future Budget Years

The FY18 project cost is \$86,184, which is 6% increase above the existing annual contract amount. DWQ recommends a contract that permits up to four (4) annual renewals at the same annual cost.
