Request

The purpose of this memorandum is to request authorization to execute an agreement awarding a FY16 Class B (Education) Stormwater Quality Projects Incentive to The Living Arts and Science Center for storm water education, at a total cost of \$34,920.00.

Purpose of Request

The purpose of this project is to develop new and build upon existing curricula of LASC programs that focus on water quality, storm water issues, and water conservation. The Living Arts and Science Center anticipates reaching over 6,000 children directly through ongoing educational programming and public outreach campaigns.

Project Cost in FY16 and in Future Budget Years

The grant has been approved by the Water Quality Fees Board in the amount of \$34,920.00 and is anticipated to be fully spent by FY18.
