SUBJECT: Palo Alto Pricing – Participating Addendum Request for the Division of

Enhanced 911

Request: Council Authorization for the Mayor to sign a Participating Addendum (PA) requesting that the Commonwealth add an existing Palo Alto price contract to the state master agreement.

Purpose of Request: On February 11, 2021 (Resolution 649-2021) Council authorized submission of a grant application to the Kentucky 911 Services Board requesting \$217,676.25 to update and refresh a Palo Alto Security Appliance/Router for the Division of Enhanced 911. The current Palo Alto Security Appliance/Router is due for a technology refresh based on the manufacturer's recommendation. This device secures the network used by the Division of Enhanced 911 and the Lexington Police Department and helps both agencies comply with Federal Bureau of Investigation Criminal Justice Information Systems (FBI-CJIS) requirements. Palo Alto has a price agreement that is honored by several states in the U.S. and the Division of Enhanced 911 would like to add Kentucky to that list. This Participating Addendum would formally request that addition.
