**SUBJECT:** Addendum No. 2 to Agreement with University of Kentucky Research

**Foundation (UKRF)** 

**Request:** Council authorization to execute Addendum No. 2 to the Agreement with the University of Kentucky Research Foundation (UKRF) in the amount of \$99,997.00 for the provision of evaluation services for Year 3 of the Expanded First Responders and Community Partners Overdose Prevention Project (EFRCPOPP) funded under the U.S. Department of Health and Human Service First Responders - Comprehensive Addiction and Recovery Support Service Grant (FR-CARA). Cost not to exceed \$99,997.

**Purpose of Request:** On December 6, 2022 (Resolution 677-2022), Council authorized execution of the agreement with UKRF to provide evaluation services pertaining to Year 1 of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government Expanded First Responders and Community Partners Overdose Prevention Project. On November 16, 2023 (Resolution 619-2023), Council authorized execution of Addendum No. 1 to the UKRF to provide evaluation services pertaining to Year 2 of the LFUCG Expanded First Responders and Community Partners Overdose Prevention Project. The purpose of the project is to reduce the number of overdose fatalities by facilitating access to naloxone through first responders and members of other key community sectors. The Division of Social Services listed the University of Kentucky Research Foundation as the required evaluator in the grant application.

What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years? \$99,997 is cost in FY25. Future budget years is dependent upon receipt of an award.

**Are the funds budgeted?** Budget amendment 13233 is in process.
