**SUBJECT: KYTC Agreement for Rosemont Garden Sidewalks Project —Design Phase**

**Request:** Council authorization to accept federal funds in the amount of \$100,000 for the design phase of Rosemont Garden Sidewalks Project as funded under the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet Office of Local Programs Transportation Alternatives Program.

**Purpose of the Request:** The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet has awarded the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government federal funds from the Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) for the design of approximately 950 feet of sidewalk along three blocks of Rosemont Garden just east of Southland Drive, where no sidewalk currently exists.


The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet has offered the LFUCG funds for design phase in the amount of \$100,000. Local match in the amount of \$25,000 is required for a total project cost of \$125,000.

**The cost in this budget year and future budget years:** Design Cost in FY 2017: \$125,000 (\$100,000 federal funds and \$25,000 local match).

**Are the funds budgeted?** Budget Amendment #8250 is in process.
