SUBJECT:

TWC Agreement for Managed Public WiFi Service for the new Lexington Senior Center

Request:

Request Council Authorization for the Mayor to execute a sixty(60) month agreement between the Lexington Senior Center and Time Warner Cable Business Class to provide Managed WiFi services for the public for the Division of Aging and Disability Services at the new Senior Center.

Purpose:

This agreement will provide the equipment and support for public WiFi access for the new Senior Center at Life Lane and includes a turn-key solution for 13 Static IP addresses with Managed WiFi and 30M dedicated Internet access for those addresses.

Budgetary Implication:

All equipment and services will be leased for a 60 month term at \$1630.01 per month beginning upon the move into the new Senior Center.

Are the funds budgeted?

The funds are fully budgeted in 1101-606102-6081-72204 for FY16, and subsequent costs shall be \$19,560 per year, provided available funds are budgeted.
