SUBJECT: Welcome Home Furniture Vouchers

Authorization to: Execute an agreement with Habitat for Humanity Re-store for a one-time grant of \$4,000 for support of their Welcome Home Project, which provides furniture vouchers to individuals/ families who have been permanently housed using the Fayette County CoC Coordinated Entry system.

## Why are you requesting?

Department needs this action completed because: Families/individuals experiencing homeless in almost all cases do not have the home furnishings or the resource to purchase necessary furniture such as a bed. These individuals/families permanently housed though the Coordinated Entry system will be given vouchers to assist with basic home furniture such as beds, couches, or dressers. This type of voucher is only available to those individuals/families permanently housed through the Coordinated Entry process and is not available to the general public or those agencies that do not participate in the Coordinated Entry process. The request for a voucher must be case manager initiated and approved/verified through OPHI. Fund allocation has been voted on and approved by the Homeless Intervention and Prevention Board under the Innovative and Sustainable Solutions Homelessness Fund.
