SUBJECT: Sub-recipient agreement awarding \$205,730 of federal American Rescue Plan Act funding to the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Human Rights Commission

Request: Council authorization to execute a Sub-recipient Agreement awarding \$205,730 of Local Recovery Funds from the American Rescue Plan Act to the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Human Rights Commission for FY 2022.

Purpose of Request:

The FY 2022 Approved Budget provides for \$205,730 of Local Recovery Funds from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) to support the operating costs of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Human Rights Commission. This is an eligible government service provided under the Revenue Recovery provision of the ARPA funding. The agency will continue to safeguard all individuals within Lexington-Fayette County from discrimination based on race, color, religion, national origin, sex, age, disability, familial status and sexual orientation/gender identity in connection with housing, employment and public accommodations and to effect the provisions and purposes of the Kentucky Civil Rights Act (KRS Chapter 3444), Urban County Ordinances 199-94 and 201-99, provision 7.17 of the Lexington-Fayette Merger Charter of 1974, and any other laws enacted by the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government relating to the Commission.

What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years?

Available funding in Fiscal Year 2022 is \$205,730

Are the funds budgeted?

Yes, funds are in the FY2022 Budget.
