Program Description* For 20 years the LFUCG Parks and Recreation has provided a low cost, summer tennis and swim day camp. The camp is held Monday-Friday, 8:30am-4pm for ages 6-14. Three tennis instructors facilitate 4 sessions of the camp and there is a maximum of 30 campers per session. This cap

on numbers provides better teacher to camper ratios. The total number of potential NJTL youth that could be captured through a JTT non-membership program is 120.

Funding would be used to enhance this camp by being able to add an NJTL component. This has been a goal of the Athletic Director and securing training and implementation of the Academic Creative Engagement (ACE) curriculum has been a goal of the Athletic Director. With the training coming to the Southern section this coming October, staff would be able to attend and ultimately implement the ACE curriculum for the LFUCG Parks and Recreation Tennis Camp.

Plans for Program Sustainability * The program has been in existence for more than 20 years and the opportunity to increase the educational and social components of the program will improve the overall experience of each camper. The program fee structure currently incorporates instructional/staffing costs and there are no court costs associated. Once the initial purchase of the ACE curriculum kits occurs, they can be used annually for years to come. Grant funding is a one-time expense and the program's long-term sustainability has been established. It is possible that the program, with the new ACE features, could be expanded through partnerships with the local indoor tennis facility, Lexington Tennis Club. With such an enhancement, the camp could be offered throughout the year.

Strategy to drive USTA Membership *

Parks and Recreation would take advantage of the free 10 and under tennis memberships for programming. Discussions about making this program membership-based, along with other programs within the LFUCG Parks and Recreation, have been ongoing. Beginning the program would most likely be non-membership JTT. The programming would include instruction for several weeks, followed by match play experience and possibly an end of season tournament. These program elements would increase exposure to USTA programming and could result in USTA Memberships.
