Hickman Wastewater Treatment Plant

The purpose of this memorandum is to request approval of a temporary right of entry agreement between Marathon Pipe Line LLC and the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government for the purpose of allowing Marathon's contractor to unload construction equipment needed to supply an adjacent Marathon pipeline project. The duration of this temporary agreement would be for a period of thirty (30) days from the date of execution. The Division of Water Quality anticipates that this agreement will be replaced by a second, more detailed agreement that would be delivered to the council for their consideration.
