SUBJECT: Acceptance of Funds from American Rescue Plan Act through Kentucky Justice

and Public Safety Cabinet for Community Corrections

Request: Authorization to accept an award from the Kentucky Justice and Public Safety Cabinet in the amount of \$193,911.39 for reimbursement of eligible expenditures incurred retroactive to March 3, 2021, as authorized under the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) for Community Corrections. No matching funds required.

Purpose of Request: The Kentucky Justice and Public Safety Cabinet is providing from the American Rescue Plan Act funding in the amount of \$193,911.39 for reimbursement of eligible costs associated with operating jail facilities that house state inmates. Eligible costs may include those related to both county and state inmates. Eligible costs include PPE, sanitation, COVID testing, and vaccinations. These funds are from the state's allocation of ARPA State and Local Rescue Funds.

What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years? \$193,911.39 is awarded through June 30, 2022. No costs are anticipated in future years. No matching funds required.

Are the funds budgeted? Budget Amendment 11263 is in process
