Request

Authorization to accept donation from RJ Corman Railroad Group to repair our railroad crossing at Safety City.

Why are you requesting?

Safety City has been a part of the Lexington Police Department since 1992, and teaches kids bicycle and traffic safety. As a part of the lesson, the children drive motorized carts along a path through a small replica of the city. A part of that replica is a railroad crossing, which has since become inactive. RJ Corman Railroad Group has offered to donate materials, valued at \$9,484.23, to repair the railroad crossing to assist children in understanding how to navigate an actual railroad crossing safely. The donation includes equipment, parts and labor to install a new railroad crossing.
