

GRANT AWARD AGREEMENT

Fiscal Year 2017 Class A Incentive Grant Program

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into on the 31st day of May, 2017 by and between the LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT, an urban county government of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, pursuant to KRS Chapter 67A (hereinafter "Government"), on behalf of its Division of Water Quality, and The Ashwood Townhomes of Laredo Association, Inc., 141 Prosperous Place, Suite #21B, Lexington, KY 40509 (hereinafter "Grantee").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Government has funds available through the Stormwater Quality Projects Incentive Grant Program to assist qualified applicants in the implementation of projects that meet the goals of the program; and

WHEREAS, the Grantee represents directly or indirectly a group of single-family residences in Fayette County who are fee-payers of the Government's Water Quality Management Fee; and

WHEREAS, the Grantee has proposed a need for the funds requested to develop and implement a proposed project by submitting a valid grant application; and

WHEREAS, the Grantee desires to implement a specific project that meets one or more Incentive Grant program goals to improve water quality, reduce stormwater runoff, and provide public or private education related to stormwater quality for the benefit of its members, community, and the general public; and

WHEREAS, the Grantee's grant application has been reviewed and selected for funding by the Government's Water Quality Fees Board in accordance with Sections 16-408 and 16-410 of the Government's Code of Ordinances;

THAT FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES AND COVENANTS HEREIN EXPRESSED, GOVERNMENT AND GRANTEE AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) The Government hereby grants the Grantee the sum of \$16,170.00 (hereinafter "the Grant"), for use in implementing the project elements as listed in Attachment A which is incorporated herein by reference as if fully set out herein.
- (2) The Grantee agrees to match the Grant with contributions, labor and other services equal to or greater than 20% of the total project cost.
- (3) The Grantee agrees to use the Grant only for the activities set forth in Attachment A.



Request

Requesting approval of a decreasing change order of \$78.96 to the Stormwater Incentive Grant with the Ashwood Townhouses of Laredo Association, Inc., Contract #007-2017.

Purpose of Request

The original grant award to the Ashwood Townhouses of Laredo Association, Inc., was for \$16,170.00; however, the grant-funded project came in under budget. The final grant award totaled \$16,091.04.

The \$78.96 from this decreasing change order request will be returned to the Stormwater Quality Projects Incentive Grant Program for award in FY21.

Project Cost in FY20 and in Future Budget Years

The decreasing change order savings of \$78.96 will be returned to fund 4052 for FY21 grant awards.
