SUBJECT: Approval of Advanced Eco Systems as a Sole Source Provider Contract to

Purchase Zumo Decontamination Accessory Kits for Hospitals for Division of

**Emergency Management** 

**Request:** Council authorization to approve Advanced Eco Systems as a sole source provider contract for the purchase of Zumro decontamination accessory kits for hospitals for the Division of Emergency Management at a cost not to exceed \$136,362.00.

**Purpose of the Request:** The Division of Emergency Management is requesting to establish Advanced Eco Systems as a sole source provider to purchase Zumro decontamination accessory kits for hospitals. The decontamination system equipment is specially manufactured and no other manufacturer provides this type of equipment. Twelve benchmarks are key in assessing capabilities and reporting on the Chemical Stockpile Emergency Preparedness Program (CSEPP) status. Each benchmark is allocated funds under CFDA 97.040. \$136,362.00 is from CSEPP FY21 State allocated funds under the Medical and Protective Actions Benchmarks KY-FAY-481.

What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years? Estimated cost is \$136,362.00. No future cost are anticipated.
