**SUBJECT: Authorization to Execute Supplemental Agreement #2 for Transportation  
Alternatives Program (TAP) funds from KYTC for Town Branch Commons  
Trail**

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**Request:** Council authorization to execute Supplemental Agreement #2 with the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet accepting federal funds of \$500,000 for the construction phase of the Town Branch Commons Trail, the acceptance of which obligates the government to provide match of \$125,000. Funds are budgeted.

**Purpose of Request:** LexTran was awarded federal funds from the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet for construction of bike/ped facilities, pedestrian crossings and other improvements at LEXTRAN Central Transit Center on Vine Street between Quality Street and Limestone. On June 23, 2016 (Resolution 410-2016), Council authorized executing an agreement with LexTran establishing LFUCG's role as fiscal agent for these grant funds, accepting the initial award of \$234,796 in federal funds for design. On March 21, 2019 (Resolution 150-2019), Council authorized acceptance of an additional \$2,495,418 of federal funds for the Construction Phase.

Supplemental Agreement #2 offers an additional \$500,000 of federal funds for the Construction Phase, the acceptance of which obligates the LFUCG to a 20% match of \$125,000. Match funds are budgeted in fund 2608.

**Cost in this Budget year and future budget years:** The cost for this FY is \$625,000 of which \$500,000 is federal grant funds and \$125,000 is local match..

**Are the funds budgeted?** Budget Amendments 10538 and 10539 are in process.
