Request

Authorization to: The Division of Emergency Management is requesting the Lexington Fayette Urban County Council to authorize the Mayor to approving the procurement of a new Emergency Outdoor Warning Siren to be installed at Raven Run Park to be purchased and installed by Federal Signal and Security Systems/Alerting and Notification as a sole source vendor. The Federal Signal Siren System is not compatible and is unable to be mixed with other brands of sirens.

Why are you requesting?

DEM has budgeted to procure and install a new Outdoor Emergency Warning Siren at Raven Run Park. In addition to ALL HAZARDS warnings, Raven Run is the closest LFUCG park to Madison County in the event of a Chemical Stockpile emergency.
