# Request

Date:

The Division of Water Quality is recommending the execution of an agreement between LFUCG and Columbia Gas for the relocation of an existing 6-inch gas main negatively impacting completion of the Wolf Run Trunk E RMP project. This agreement contemplates a \$14,786.00 cost to LFUCG for the relocation.

# Purpose of Request

The purpose of this request is to execute the necessary documents required by Columbia Gas. The above referenced gas line, previously unidentified during the design phase of this project, is in direct conflict with the proposed sanitary sewer improvements and must be relocated in order to complete the project.

### Replace and Repair Cost in FY22

This agreement contemplates a \$14,786.00 cost to LFUCG for relocating the gas line but allows for reconciliation of actual costs (more or less than the estimate). There is no impact to future fiscal years.
