SUBJECT: Institute of Police Technology and Management (IPTM)

Request: Lexington Police requests Council authorization to use grant funds in the amount of \$70,000 to host four IPTM 40-hour training courses. Each training course costs \$17,500 and allows up to 30 officers to attend.

Purpose of Request: IPTM will travel to the hosting department per training class. The first course is scheduled for June 15, 2026, and is entitled Pedestrian/Bicycle Crash Investigation. The second class will be held on July 06, 2026, and is entitled Investigation of Motorcycle Crashes. The third class will be held on July 20, 2026, and is entitled Interviewing Techniques for the Traffic Crash Investigator. The final class will be held on August 03, 2026, and is entitled Event Data Recorder Use in Traffic Reconstruction.

If approved, Lexington Police Department would plan and host the training for their officers and several other officers within the state of Kentucky. This is a significant cost decrease from paying each individual student to travel to each of the courses.

What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years? A total of \$70,000 of the grant funding will go to these four training courses.
