SUBJECT:

Request Council authorization to amend Resolution 222-2014, providing for

a price increase by Time Warner Cable for high speed internet used for the LFUCG AM radio station for the Division of Emergency Management/911.

On May 8, 2014 (Resolution No. 222-2014), Council authorized execution of a service agreement with Time Warner Cable for high speed internet for the LFUCG AM radio station. Services included broadband and one static IP address.

Resolution No. 222-2014 provided for expenditure of \$840 for broadband services with one static address.

Time Warner Cable has increased its prices and is now requiring that IP static addresses be purchased in blocks of five. New price is now \$1,260 annually for 36 months. Total for three years is \$3,780.
