

**MOTION**

- (a) *Docket Approval*: I move to place on the docket for tonight's Council meeting a resolution authorizing the Mayor, on behalf of the Urban County Government, to execute a First Amendment to Purchase of Service Agreement with the following Extended Social Resource Program agencies, authorizing additional funding for services related to food insecurity: Foodchain, Inc.; Glean Kentucky; God's Pantry Food Bank, Inc.; Greenhouse17; Lexington Pride Center; Moveable Feast Lexington, Inc.; and the Nathaniel Mission, at an additional cost not to exceed \$208,025.00 in Fiscal Year 2026.
- (b) *Budget Amendment*: I move that the Budget Amendment Request List on page 4 of the Work Session Packet be amended to add a budget amendment to provide budget in the amount of \$208,025 to ESR Program agencies for services related to food insecurity. Funds are available in the unallocated fund balance to fund these allocations.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, ON BEHALF OF THE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT, TO EXECUTE A FIRST AMENDMENT TO PURCHASE OF SERVICE AGREEMENTS WITH THE FOLLOWING EXTENDED SOCIAL RESOURCE (ESR) PROGRAM GRANTEE AGENCIES, AUTHORIZING ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR SERVICES PROVIDED TO THE PUBLIC PURSUANT TO RFP #20-2024 (FOOD INSECURITY AND NUTRITIONAL ACCESS): FOODCHAIN, INC. (\$24,184.00); GLEAN KENTUCKY (\$4,000.00); GOD'S PANTRY FOOD BANK, INC. (\$108,480.00); GREENHOUSE17 (\$10,000.00); LEXINGTON GAY SERVICES ORGANIZATION D/B/A LEXINGTON PRIDE CENTER (\$15,561.00); MOVEABLE FEAST LEXINGTON, INC. (\$23,000); AND THE NATHANIEL MISSION (\$22,800.00), AT AN ADDITIONAL COST NOT TO EXCEED \$208,025.00 IN FISCAL YEAR 2026.

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BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT:

Section 1 – That the Mayor, on behalf of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government, be and hereby is authorized to execute a First Amendment to Purchase of Service Agreements, which are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, with Foodchain, Inc.; Glean Kentucky; God's Pantry Food Bank, Inc.; Greenhouse17; Lexington Gay Services Organization d/b/a Lexington Pride Center; Moveable Feast Lexington, Inc.; and The Nathaniel Mission, authorizing additional funding for services provided to the public in FY2026 pursuant to RFP #20-2024 (Food Insecurity and Nutritional Access).

Section 2 – That an amount not to exceed the sum of \$208,025.00, be and hereby is approved for payment to the following grantee agencies in the following amounts from the following accounts: Foodchain, Inc. (\$24,184.00) from account #1101-900361-0001-71101; Glean Kentucky (\$4,000.00) from account #1101-900350-0001-71101; God's Pantry Food Bank, Inc. (\$108,480.00) from account #1101-900323-0001-71101; Greenhouse17 (\$10,000.00) from account #1101-900304-0001-71101; Lexington Gay Services Organization d/b/a Lexington Pride Center (\$15,561.00) from account #1101-900376-0001-71101; Moveable Feast Lexington, Inc. (\$23,000.00) from account #1101-900324-0001-71101; and The Nathaniel Mission (\$22,800.00) from account #1101-900374-0001-71101, pursuant to the terms of the respective First Amendment to Purchase of Service Agreement.

Section 3 – That this Resolution shall become effective on the date of its passage.
