Amend Resolution 576-2013

(Council Meeting -November 7, 2013)

The Division of Water Quality has requested an amendment to Council Resolution 576-2013, Section 3, removing Fidele Nsonguh Tibouo, Environmental Inspector, Grade 113N, \$16.843 hourly in the Division of Water Quality, effective October 21, 2013. The Division of Water Quality has requested to further amend Council Resolution 576-2013, Section 1, adding Fidele Nsonguh Tibouo, Environmental Inspector, Grade 113N, \$16.843 hourly in the Division of Water Quality, effective upon passage of Council.

The amendments correct the type of Civil Service Position that the Division of Water Quality intended to fill and the effective date. Specifically, the conditional offer was for a Classified Civil Service position rather than an Unclassified Civil Service position as stated in the resolution. The amendment would be consistent with the way the vacant position was advertised, and the Mayor has approved the Division of Water Quality's revised request for appointment.
