Please be advised of the following clarifications to the above referenced bid:

- 1) The current cost for full-service cleaning is \$35.95 per day and spray buffing is \$27.80 per day.
- 2) The Training Room Area on the second floor, 605 sq ft VCT, is not included in the contract.
- 3) Contractor is not responsible for emptying outside trash cans.
- 4) An area will be provided in the first floor meeting hall for storage of supplies.

EQUAL OPPORTUNITY AGREEMENT

The Law
