

SUBJECT: Recommendation for an FY25 (Class B Education) Stormwater Quality Projects
Incentive Grant for Fayette County Public Schools.

Request

The purpose of this memorandum is to request approval of an FY25 (Class B Education) Stormwater Quality Projects Incentive Grant for Fayette County Public Schools in the amount of \$4,976.50.

Purpose of Request

The purpose of this project is to optimize the use of an existing detention basin on Tates Creek Elementary Schools (TCE) south campus as a stormwater educational tool. The project elements include a planting day hosted by Fayette County Public School (FCPS) and Hickman Creek Conservancy (HCC), five (5) water quality watershed and native planting lessons for 4th and 5th grade classes, and a field trip to Gainesway pond after all work has been completed. The project also includes installation of a permanent educational sign on the sidewalk side of the basin.

Project Cost in FY25 and in Future Budget Years

The grant has been approved for FY 2025 funding by the Water Quality Fees Board in the amount of \$4,976.50.
