Assurance Program and Fees Collected by the Program

Request

The purpose of this memorandum is to request approval of a professional services agreement for Bell Engineering to complete a program audit of the Capacity Assurance Program (CAP) and collected fees.

Purpose of Request

The CAP Ordinance outlined a formal review/audit to be completed before July 3, 2015, however the CAP was not implemented until July 3, 2013. Bell's program audit will cover the first two (2) full years (July 3, 2013 through July 3, 2015) of the System Capacity Assurance Program—which was the intent of the Water Quality Management Fee Task Force that reviewed, refined and then endorsed the program criteria

Project Cost in FY16 and in Future Budget Years

Bell's fee for services is \$27,100, and the funds will be spent in FY16. There is no budgetary impact associated with this contract for future fiscal years.
