SUBJECT: FY16 ADOPT-A-SPOT ROADWAY CLEANUP PROGRAM UNDER THE KENTUCKY PRIDE GRANT

Request:

Request Council authorization to execute agreements with various nonprofit organizations for participation in the Adopt-A-Spot Roadway Cleanup Program under the Kentucky Pride Grant for FY16

Purpose of Request:

On October 22, 2015 (Resolution # 638-2015), the Urban County Council approved acceptance of state funds from the Kentucky Energy and Environment Cabinet providing for litter cleanups on Fayette County roadways. The LFUCG Department of Environmental Quality and Public Works uses a portion of these funds to support the Adopt-a-Spot program. The Adopt-a-Spot program includes the participation of non-profit organizations that conduct litter pickups on designated roadways four times per year. This program was implemented several years ago in response to a request from citizens who voiced a need for litter pick-up on public roadways. The following additional groups are being added to the Adopt-a-Spot program.


