Proposed Reorganization Goals

- Create clear points of (a) contact and (b) responsibility for vegetation management on LFUCG owned and operated land and natural resource areas.
- 2. Match divisional responsibilities to divisional focus, mission, and subject matter expertise.
- 3. Fill current gaps in resources and assignments.

- 1. Council Resolution: Change the name of the Division of Environmental Policy to the Division of Environmental Services.
- 2. Equipment Purchase: Budget Amendment on 10/21 Council Docket to reallocate \$321,000 of unspent bond funds for purchase of equipment for the Department of Environmental Quality and Public Works to provide for centralized/year round forestry operations in expanded *Division of Environmental Services*.

- 3. Change in Divisional Assignments to begin December 1, 2014:
 - A. Division of Parks and Recreation will continue to mow and perform landscape maintenance on:
 - Parks
 - Greenways in Parks
 - Trail properties with hard surfaced trails
 - Downtown Streetscapes
 - B. Other *Parks and Recreation* mowing and landscape maintenance duties will transition to *Division of Environmental Services*, including:
 - Corridors
 - Right-of-way/Medians
 - Vacant lots/Water Quality Lots/Detention Basins
 - Other Facilities
 - Greenways not in Parks or with hard-surfaced trails
 - County Roads

- **4. Budget Transfers: Budget Amendments** on 11/13 Council Docket to transfer related funds from *Parks and Recreation* to *Environmental Services* for remainder of FY2015 operations for:
 - Greenway Maintenance Professional Services
 - Mowing Professional Services and Expenses
 - Mowing Seasonal Personnel
- **5.** Personnel Transfers: Resolutions and Budget Amendments on 11/13 Council Docket for:
 - Transfer of 2 Vacant Public Worker Senior positions from Parks & Recreation to Environmental Services.
 - Transfer of 1 Vacant Equipment Operator Senior position from Streets & Roads to Environmental Services.

6. Needed Funding for Professional Services:

Tree Removal and County Road Maintenance \$80,000

Corridors Landscaping Clean Up and Maintenance \$70,000

Corridors Beautification/Breeders Cup Preparation \$100,000





- 1. Create 3 Civil Service Positions in Environmental Services
 - 1 Arborist
 - 1 Environmental Inspector/Horticulturalist
 - 1 Program Manager Sr. (Section Manager)
- 2. Continue increased funding levels to maintain service.
