Mr. Gabe Knowles,

Petition cards were sent from Traffic Engineering via certified mail to the property owners on Longview Drive between Clays Mill Road and Harrodsburg Road soliciting a response for or against the installation of five speed tables Longview Drive.

A total of seventy-five (75) postage paid petition cards, letters, and proposed speed table location maps were mailed to all the property owners on Longview Drive in the study area. At the time of writing of this memo one petition letter was returned. This changes the eligible vote total to seventy-four (74) eligible votes for this study with a necessary total of thirty-eight (38) yes votes needed for the passage for speed tables on Longview Drive. Fifty-two (52) ballot cards were returned with votes. The breakdown of those votes includes:

Of the fifty-two ballot cards returned:

- Thirty-nine (39) votes, or 53% of the adjusted total were in favor of the installation of speed tables
- Twelve (12) votes, or 16% of the adjusted total were opposed
- One (1) ballot card was received with a Yes vote but was unsigned.

With 53% votes in favor of the installation of speed tables received and exceeding the minimum of 51%, or thirty-eight (38), votes in favor of the proposed action, the proposal to install speed tables on Longview Drive to address speeding issues has passed. Traffic Engineering recommends the installation of three (3) speed tables on Longview Drive and will work to submit documentation for a Council Resolution to be created and passed for this initiative.
