Request

The purpose of this memorandum is to request approval of a FY19 (Class A) Stormwater Quality Projects Incentive Grant for Meadowthorpe Neighborhood Association, Inc. in the amount of \$8,701.00.

Purpose of Request

Grant funds will provide support for the Meadowthorpe Street Tree Project. The project elements include two (2) tree planting events, neighborhood workshops, and educational signage. Additional stormwater education by way of collaborations with the Urban Forest Initiative (UFI) and the UK Cooperative Extension Service on training and programming related to urban tree benefits, planting/maintenance, inventory, and assessment.

Project Cost in FY19 and in Future Budget Years

The grant has been approved by the Water Quality Fees Board in the amount of \$8,701.00 and will be fully spent by FY20.
