SUBJECT Grant Application for submission to the Kentucky Energy and Environment Cabinet/Division of Waste Management under the Household Hazardous Waste Management Grant program

Request:

Council authorization is requested to submit an application, and accept award if offered, to the Department of Environmental Quality—Division of Waste Management in the amount of \$104,585 for the support of a one-day household hazardous waste recycling event for Fayette County.

Purpose of Request:

The Division of Waste Management has prepared an application for submission to the state agency requesting funds for support of a one-day county-wide household waste recycling even. Funds will be used to contract with a vendor for appropriate disposal of hazardous waste. The Recycling and Household Hazardous Waste Grants Program was established in 2006 by Senate Bill 50. KRS 224.43-505 (2)(c) specifies the establishment of a Recycling and Household Hazardous Waste management grants program.

Cost in this budget year and future budget years:

State funds in the amount of \$104,585 will be budgeted in Fiscal Year 2017. A match of \$26,147 will be budgeted in the Urban Services Funds (Fund 1115). Total cost will be \$130,732. No expenses are anticipated for future budget years.

Are funds budgeted? Budget amendments for Fiscal Year 2017 are in process.
