This **TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION EASEMENT** is made and entered into this the 21 day of April, 2016, by and between **RACHEL M. MASON AND NICHOLAS J. W I T N E S S E T H:

That for and in consideration of the sum of **SIX HUNDRED DOLLARS AND 00/100 (\$600.00)**, and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, said Grantors have **BARGAINED** and **SOLD** and do hereby **GIVE, GRANT** and **CONVEY** unto the Grantee, its successors and assigns, temporary right to excavate, grade, construct, alter, re-grade and perform related work for the purpose of roadway improvements and construction, installation and relocation through and across the following tract of land located in the confines of Lexington, Fayette County, Kentucky, and more particularly described as follows, to wit:

Thence North 49 degrees 22 minutes 47 seconds East, 39.98 feet to a point 45.01 feet left of Mt. Tabor Road station 18+15.75;

Thence South 40 degrees 06 minutes 23 seconds East, 13.10 feet to a point 31.91 feet left of Mt. Tabor Road station 18+15.62;

Thence South 49 degrees 15 minutes 24 seconds West, 40.00 feet to a point of beginning;

The above described parcel contains .012 acres (525 sq. ft.) of temporary easement; and,


