

ORDINANCE NO. __35____-2017

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CERTAIN OF THE BUDGETS OF THE LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT TO REFLECT CURRENT REQUIREMENTS FOR FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$50,616.00 IN THE DIVISION OF TRAFFIC ENGINEERING FROM THE COUNCIL PROJECTS FUNDS FOR DRIVER AND PEDESTRIAN SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS ON REED LANE BETWEEN SOUTHPORT DRIVE AND LAFAYETTE PARKWAY, AND APPROPRIATING AND RE-APPROPRIATING FUNDS, SCHEDULE NO. 0040.

WHEREAS, it is necessary and proper to amend the budgets of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government to reflect current requirements for funds in the amount of \$50,616.00 in the Division of Traffic Engineering from the Council Projects Funds for driver and pedestrian safety improvements on Reed Lane between Southport Drive and Lafayette Parkway.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT:

Section 1 - That certain of the Budgets of the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government be and hereby are amended to reflect current requirements for funds in the amount of \$50,616.00 in the Division of Traffic Engineering from the Council Projects Funds for driver and pedestrian safety improvements on Reed Lane between Southport Drive and Lafayette Parkway and that to effect such Amendments the following appropriations be and hereby are authorized and directed:

) Re-appropriations within the General Fund – Capital Projects Fund which do not result in changes to the Unappropriated Fund Balance of these respective funds.

Section 2 - That the purposes of the Budget Amendments and the Accounts to or from which funds are herein appropriated, are detailed in Schedule No. 0040, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 3 - That this Ordinance shall become effective on the date of its passage.
