Request

The purpose of this memorandum is to request approval for the purchase of replacement parts for the bar screen located at the Lower Cane Run Pump Station and at the North Elkhorn Pump Station. The manufacturer, E & I Corporation is the sole source for these components.

Purpose of Request

Repair is required because the bar screens at these pump stations, which remove grit, rags, and other debris from the influent to the pump stations have become structurally unreliable.

Replace and repair Cost in FY16

The quote from E & I Corporation for this equipment is \$21,394.00 for Lower Cane Run and \$29,057.00 for North Elkhorn. This amount does not include shipping and handling.
