Administrative Synopsis - New Business Items

Authorization to enter into an agreement with the sole source provider Target Solutions Learning, LLC. for an online training platform to provide online access to learning modules for Fire Recruits during pre-entry training, (EMS, Firefighter I, Firefighter II, etc.) The cost for this FY is \$6,255.00. Future cost is 2.5% increase per year at \$4,755.00 - \$4,873.88. Funds are budgeted. (L0214-16) (Chilton/Bastin)

0368-16 Authorization for the Mayor to execute а Memorandum of between LFUCG the Understanding and Lexington-Favette County Health Department to provide substance abuse referrals during the Needle Exchange Program. This MOU will provide substance abuse treatment referrals by the Department of Services' Substance Abuse and Violence (SAVI) Program for those who utilize the Needle Exchange Program and are seeking substance abuse treatment services for addiction. There is no budgetary impact. (L0368-15)(Ford)

- Authorization to create and establish for bid a non-exclusive Telecommunications Franchise Agreement for the placement of facilities for the generation, transmission, distribution and sale of telecommunications or related non-cable services within public rights-of-way of Fayette County. This property must be acquired for construction of new East Hickman Sanitary Pump Station and Wet Weather Storage Tank. This is a Consent Decree project. The cost is \$25,000.00. Funds are budgeted. q	<u>0416-16</u>	Authorization to accept the Master Services and Purchasing Agreement with TASER International, Inc. (TASER) for

purchase of body worn cameras. This agreement sets forth the terms and conditions for the purchase, delivery, use and support of TASER products and services. The cost of the June 1, 2016 - May 31, 2017 portion of this agreement will be partially covered in the FY16 budget, and is pending approval of funds requested in the FY17 budget. Total cost is \$879,995.00 (L0416-16) (Barnard/Bastin)
