

TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION EASEMENT

This **TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION EASEMENT** is made and entered into this the 21 day of April, 2016, by and between **JASON B. ROBINSON**, a single person, 208 Pleasant Pointe Drive, Lexington, Kentucky 40517, which is the in-care of tax mailing address for the current year ("Grantor"), and **LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY GOVERNMENT**, 200 East Main Street, Lexington, Kentucky 40507, ("Grantee").

W I T N E S S E T H:

That for and in consideration of the sum of **SIX HUNDRED DOLLARS AND 00/100 (\$600.00)**, and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, said Grantor has **BARGAINED** and **SOLD** and does hereby **GIVE, GRANT** and **CONVEY** unto the Grantee, its successors and assigns, temporary right to excavate, grade, construct, alter, re-grade and perform related work for the purpose of roadway improvements and construction, installation and relocation through and across the following tract of land located in the confines of Lexington, Fayette County, Kentucky, and more particularly described as follows, to wit:

Thence North 40 degrees 06 minutes 23 seconds West, 13.10 feet to a point 45.01 feet left of Mt. Tabor Road station 18+15.75;

Thence North 49 degrees 17 minutes 14 seconds East, 40.02 feet to a point 45.01 feet left of Mt. Tabor Road station 18+55.87;

Thence South 40 degrees 00 minutes 58 seconds East, 13.31 feet to a point 31.70 feet left of Mt. Tabor Road station 18+55.69;

Thence South 49 degrees 35 minutes 07 seconds West, 40.00 feet to the point of beginning;

The above described parcel contains .012 acres (528 sq. ft.) of temporary easement; and,


