SUBJECT:

Create position - Department of Planning, Preservation and Development

The attached action amends Section 22-5 of the Code of Ordinances, creating one (1) position of Affordable Housing Manger (Grade 120E) for a term of 48 months within the Department of Planning, Preservation and Development, effective upon passage by Council.

This new position will serve as the face of Lexington's Affordable Housing program and work in conjunction with the Affordable Housing Board to study housing market conditions, propose affordable housing programs, evaluate the financial design of proposed affordable housing projects, and coordinate with government and partner agency entities to monitor and evaluate affordable housing in Lexington.

The fiscal impact for FY2015 (26 pay periods) will be a cost of \$95,504.81 and will be funded from the Affordable Housing Fund **1145 162101 1601 78112** and a budget amendment will follow. All costs include benefits.
