

1.12 RFP Requirements - Scope of Work

GRW proposes the following Scope of Work for this project:

1.12.1 Project Planning

A project schematic illustrating the project boundary, flight lines, photo-centers and mapping control locations for each site will be prepared.

1.12.2 Control Surveys

GRW will utilize Integrated Engineering (DBE) as our survey subconsultant team member to fulfill the 10% DBE requirement for this project. The GRW Team will establish a total of seventy six (76) mapping control points for this project. Wherever possible, photo identifiable physical feature control points will be used. In areas where such points are not available, an iron pin with cap driven flush to the ground or a "mag nail" driven flush with the pavement surface will be set and targeted prior to the flight mission. Targets will be constructed of woven plastic material or paint with each individual leg of the target measuring 12 inches wide by 4 feet in total length. The targets will be in the shape of a "V" or "L". GRW will obtain 3rd order or better horizontal and vertical control data for each mapping control point using GPS survey techniques. The control network will be based on Kentucky State Plane North Zone NAD83 horizontal coordinate system and NAVD88 Vertical datum.

1.12.3 Aerial Image Acquisition

GRW will use one of our three turbo-charged aircraft equipped with one of our three large format aerial mapping cameras to obtain new color aerial imagery at 1"=300 ft. negative scale with 60% forward overlap. A total of fifteen (15) flight lines and seventy one (71) exposures will be acquired. Upon completion of the color film processing, GRW will scan each processed negative at 16 microns resulting in a raster image with a raw pixel size of 0.19 ft.

1.12.4 Digital Mapping

Once the color imagery has been scanned GRW will accomplish aerial triangulation on each strip of imagery to extend the field control network across multiple aerial images. The final mapping solution will be established using PAT-B bundle adjustment software.

Our experienced staff of photogrammetrists will then provide 1"=20 ft. digital planimetric feature collection from the aerial imagery using softcopy 3-D stereo-compilation techniques. The digital mapping will cover 200 feet each side of the pipeline alignments and 50 feet outside the property limits of treatment plants and pump station sites. Features to be collected (but not limited to) include:

- Paved and Unpaved roads
- Driveways, Parking lots, R/R's
- Public and Residential Sidewalks
- Building Structures
- Fences and Walls

- Recreational Features
- Lakes, Ponds, Rivers, Streams
- Grouped Tree Lines
- Single Landmark Trees
- All Identifiable Utility Features

Once all the Planimetric features have been collected, a Digital Terrain Model (DTM) will be created. Break lines along linear features and top and bottom of changes in slopes will be collected. Mass points will be collected every twenty feet on flat to gently rolling surfaces. The final DTM will be used to
