Rehabilitation through March 31, 2016

Request:

Request Council authorization to execute Amendment to Agreement with the Hope Center for rehabilitation of the emergency shelter, extending the performance period through March 31, 2016

Why are you requesting?

The 2013 Consolidated Plan, approved by Council on April 25, 2013 (Resolution No. 175-2013) provided \$200,000 in Community Development Block Grant funds for rehabilitation of the emergency shelter for men located at 360 West Loudon Avenue and operated by The Hope Center. The Hope Center has requested additional time to complete rehabilitation. The proposed amendment provides for an extended performance period through March 31, 2016.

What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years?

No additional cost in this budget year or in future budget years is anticipated for shelter rehabilitation.

Are the funds budgeted? All grant funds are budgeted.
