SUBJECT: Institute of Police Technology and Management (IPTM) Agreement

Request: Council authorization to execute an agreement between the Institute of Police Technology and Management (IPTM) and the Lexington Police Department for thirty officers to attend three IPTM 40-hour training courses and one 24-hour training course. Cost not to exceed \$57,000.

Purpose of Request: The Lexington Police Department (LPD) requests an agreement with Institute of Police Technology and Management to allow the LPD to host four IPTM courses during the grant fund year. These courses will allow up to 30 officers to attend with no travel costs or per diem, if local. IPTM travels to the hosting department per training class, which is a significant cost decrease from paying for each individual officer to travel to attend the courses. If approved, the LPD will schedule and host the training for their officers and several other officers within the state of Kentucky.

What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years? Total cost in FY24 is \$57,000. No future cost anticipated in future budget years.

Are the funds budgeted? Yes, funds are from Traffic Safety Grant (TRAFSAFTY_2024); 3160-505505-5543-74102
