

As a result of the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021, plan sponsors must complete an ongoing extensive analysis regarding broad plan limits, Quantitative Treatment Limits (QTLs), and Non-Quantitative Treatment Limitations (NQTLs) of their plans. As of February 10, 2021, plan sponsors are required to complete an analysis of their plan that must be made available to plan members and the Department of Labor (DOL) upon request. The analysis must be performed on all vendors offering services under the plan including TPA, PBM, networks, utilization management vendors, telemedicine, and any other vendor that may play a role in treatment limitations for mental health and substance use disorder benefits. Comparative analysis is required to maintain ongoing compliance. This involves ongoing analysis of networks, vendors, expected claim amounts, formularies and provider reimbursements. To that end, MHPAEA compliance requires ongoing work.
