Pursuant to Part V Special Conditions – Items 4, please accept this as Marrillia's request for extension of time based on the attached abnormal weather conditions experienced in February 2015. These weather impacts delayed the critical path of the project and we are requesting that the substantial completion date be extended by 10 days. The major snow event that started early morning of Monday, February 16<sup>th</sup> left the exterior site unsafe for critical path work on the foundations. The extreme cold temperature also prevented workers from being outside safely. The exterior critical path work was suspended from 2/16 - 3/1.
