SUBJECT: Amendment to Agreement with Lextran for the Comprehensive Operational

Analysis (COA) Agreement for Transit Planning Funding Section 5303

(CFDA 20.505)

Request: Council authorization to execute an amendment to Lextran's Comprehensive Operation Analysis (COA) agreement to extend the period of performance through June 30, 2022.

Purpose of the Request: On December 7, 2021 (Resolution 696-2021), Council authorized acceptance of \$125,677 in Federal Transit Section 5303 Funds for completion of Lextran's Comprehensive Operational Analysis (COA) and extended LFUCG's contract with KYTC to June 30, 2022. The agreement between LFUCG and Lextran expired on June 30, 2020. Since LFUCG is a pass through for these funds, a current agreement is required between LFUCG and Lextran to ensure compliance with all grant requirements. This action will amend the original agreement to extend the deadline until June 30, 2022.
