



Re: Requesting authorization to execute an agreement awarding a Class B (Education) Stormwater Quality Projects Incentive Grant to the Board of Education of Fayette County, Kentucky for a project located at Lansdowne Elementary School, at a total cost not to exceed \$3,500.00.

The grant application of the Board of Education of Fayette County was reviewed and recommended by the Water Quality Fees Board at its July 12, 2012 meeting. Funding is provided by revenue from the Water Quality Management Fee and is fully budgeted and available in the Fund 4051 303204 3373 78112. This grant requires a minimum 50% cost share by the grant recipient above the first \$2,500. The Grant Award Agreements require the Mayor's signature.

Grant Project Description

Design and construct a rain garden on the Lansdowne Elementary School campus. Incorporate the rain garden into the environmental education curriculum and provide community outreach.
