Request Council authorization to execute a contract agreement with Red River Ranch, LLC

for transporting and composting of yard waste and other organics at Haley Pike Composting

Facility

Request: The purpose of this memorandum is to request approval of a contract agreement with Red River Ranch, LLC for transporting and composting of yard waste and other organics at Haley Pike Composting Facility.

Authorization to: Execute a contract with Red River Ranch, LLC

Why are you requesting? Red River Ranch is the sole bidder on RFP 29-2021. The price per ton for hauling to the Haley Pike compost pad is \$21.39. This is a \$2.24 per ton increase over the previous contract. For contaminated loads, the hauling disposal rate is \$17.87 per ton. This is an increase of \$10.43 per ton but should also encourage the composting of loads. The overall compost rate is \$26.87 per ton which is a \$2.12 per ton increase over the previous contract. The contract should produce a greater composting yield from the material collected. Lexington averages over 22,000 tons of yard waste per year.

What is the cost in this budget year and future budget year?

The cost for this FY is: \$486,793 (Hauling); \$611,507 (Composting); \$211,026 (Disposal)

The cost for future FY is: \$500,000 (Hauling); \$620,000 (Composting); \$110,000 (Disposal)
