SUBJECT: Amendment to Agreements with Arbor Youth Services, Inc.

Request: Council authorization to execute amendment to agreement with Arbor Youth Services, Inc. to move Emergency Solutions Grant funds in the amount \$10,000 from case management to rapid rehousing, and authorizing the Mayor to execute any other agreements or amendments with Arbor Youth Services, Inc. related to the use of these funds.

Purpose of Request: On May 6, 2021 (Resolution 233-2021), Council authorized to submit 2021 Consolidated Plan and accept award for FY2021 federal funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for the Community Development Block Grant Program in the amount of \$2,404,696, HOME Investment Partnerships Program in the amount of \$1,324,387, and Emergency Solutions Grants Program in the amount of \$207,017, and to authorize execution of agreements with subrecipients in accordance with approved plan subject to final Federal allocation amounts for Fiscal Year 2021.

Arbors Youth Services, Inc. \$38,143 was awarded for a Rapid Rehousing Program for youth between ages of 18 and 24 who are homeless or at risk of homelessness. A grant adjustment is needed to reduce case management and increase rapid rehousing in the amount of \$10,000.

What is the cost in this budget year and future budget years? All funds were previously budgeted. Funds for future budget years are dependent upon availability of grant funds.
