Statement of Agreement

- 1. Grantee will successfully complete the Recycle Challenge Program to increase residential participation in the city recycling program.
- 2. Upon the completion of the Recycle Challenge Program, Grantee will propose a use for the funds requested for benefit to students outside of the scope of standard school budget.
- 3. Disbursement of grant funds will be as follows:

100% upon completion of the Project and submission of proposed use of funds in the following amounts:

Up to \$12,000 - ARLINGTON ELEMENTARY

Up to \$12,000 - HARRISON ELEMENTARY

Up to \$12,000 - WILLIAM WELLS BROWN ELEMENTARY

- 4. The Government assumes no responsibility whatsoever in the project activities. Grantee promises and agrees that it will hold the Government harmless from any and all liability for personal injury, property damage, or loss of life or property resulting from or in any way connected with the activities carried out pursuant to this agreement or the Grant award.
- 5. The Government must approve all proposed changes to this Agreement. The Grantee must provide written explanation of any proposed changes and the reason for those changes.
- 6. In any written or oral communications, the Grantee shall identify the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government's Department of Environmental Quality & Public Works as the source of the above-reference funds; the Grantee shall not specifically identify any individual Councilmember as being responsible for the funds donated by the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government.
- 7. The grantee agrees to comply with all applicable local and state rules, ordinances and laws during the course of the project, and in connection with any use of the funds.
